



GENSOURCE ANNOUNCES NAME CHANGE AND AMALGAMATION WITH SUBSIDIARIES

SASKATOON, Saskatchewan – June 28, 2013 – Gensource Capital Corporation (“**Gensource**” or the “**Company**”) (**TSX.V: GSP**) is pleased to announce that it will be changing its name from "Gensource Capital Corporation" to "Gensource Potash Corporation" effective July 1, 2013, reflecting the Company's focus on potash development.
